MARKITA ALDRIDGE-MISS BASKETBALL

Detroit King's Markita Aldridge became the 10th recipient of the Miss Basketball Award. A 5 foot 10 guard, Aldridge is the first women's player from the Detroit Public School League to win the award. She received 307 election points from BCAM members. Markita Robinson of Detroit Murray-Wright was second in the balloting with 168 points. Evelyn Baskin of Grand Rapids Ottawa Hills was third with 129 points.

King's principal, Sandra Robinson, attended the award presentation at the Detroit Free Press because she considered Aldridge more than a basketball player. "She represents what this is all about - the total athlete and the scholar", Robinson said. This issue of the newsletter indicates that Markita also made the BCAM Academic All State Team with a 3.67 grade point.
