SALLY SEDLAR (MANISTEE) VOTED MISS BASKETBALL

Sally Sedlar of Manistee HS was selected by BCAM members as the best girls basketball player in Michigan. Sedlar was named on November 29, 1993 as the 13th recipient of the Miss Basketball Award, given annually to the state's top senior by the BCAM in conjunction with the Lansing State Journal.

Sedlar, 5-feet-9, signed with Toledo. She has started all 92 games in her high school career, in which Manistee has an 82-10 record. Sedlar has totaled over 1,500 career points. This season she averaged 21.2 points, 5.3 rebounds, 5.1 assists, 4.4 blocked shots and 4.0 steals for Coach Mike Munro.

In the classroom, she has a 3.7 grade-point average. Sedlar isn't the tallest or quickest player in the state, and she might not be the best shooter, either. But no player can control a game from baseline to baseline like Sedlar -- offensively or defensively.

"I've always looked up to all the previous Miss BB players," Sedlar said. "I remember when Markita Aldridge (Detroit King) won the award. I was a freshman and I started thinking it would be cool to win it. But I never actually thought I could win it. I never thought I was that good."

Sedlar is the second Manistee player to win the Miss Basketball award. Ten years ago, Michele Kruty won the award. Sally has been wearing Michele's jersey number 43 for four years.
