

The 16th Annual Michigan High School Basketball All Star Festival took place once again at our home away from home, Flint Powers High School on June 22. Home away from home because Powers has been host for three consecutive years and will be the host school for the next three years under the auspices of Kathy McGee, Flint Powers' athletic director and the Charger's Athletic Boosters.

FIRST SESSION: In the opener, the Women's C/D was another classic. The Purple Team coached by **Anne Rexford** (Waterford Our Lady of the Lakes) outscored the Green Team, coached by **Paul Cook** (Lansing Catholic Central) 4-2 in overtime to post a 72-70 victory. The second game of the morning session featured the Class A/B Womens' All Stars. This session featured Miss Basketball 1996, Maxann Reese (Redford Bishop Borgess). Coach Ron Mott (Okemos) took the reigns of the Red Team and pulled out an 87-81 victory over Frank Orlando's (Detroit Country Day) Blue Team. Receiving MVP honors for the Womens' A/B session were: Katy Kamp (Stevensville-Lakeshore) for the Blue Team and Alison Miller (Grand Haven) for the Red Team. Kamp had a double-double with 16 points and 13 boards. The Red Team was led by Miller with 16 points, followed by Jamie Ahlgren (Muskegon Mona Shores) and Rachelle Guyton (Detroit Kettering) with 12 points each. Kamp was joined in double figures scoring department by Kenisha Walker (Grand Rapids Creston) and Kerry Dugan (Detroit Country Day) with 11 and 10 points respectively. In the rebounding department Shana Lynch (Fraser) assisted Kamp by adding 7 rebound of her own.

SECOND SESSION: In the second session of the day, the Mens' C/D lived up to its excitement. The Purple Team coached by **Dave Soules** (Detroit East Catholic) outscored the Green Team coached by **Rick Zoulek** (Shelby) 98-90. Receiving MVP honors for the game were: for the Purple Team, **Pete Moe** (Constantine) and for the Green Team, **Josh Ode** (Freeland). The Purple Team was led by **Dennis Smolinski** (Rogers City) with 14 points. He was joined in the scoring double figure department by **Bryan Cranson** (Bronson), **Jason Charbonneau** (Ishpeming) and **Jim Hammerberg** (Baraga Area) with 13, 12 and 11 points respectively. The Green Team was led by **Jeremy Smith** (Allen Park Cabrini) who led all scorers with 22 points. In double-double were **Ode** and **Smith** adding 11 and 12 boards respectively to their scoring. Additional rebound leaders included **Moe** with 9 and **Hammerberg** with 8.

The final event of the day concluded with the Red Team coached by **Tom Dykema** (Grand Rapids South Christian) favoring the Blue Team which was guided by **Steve Majerle** (Mount Pleasant) by a 116-109 margin. Receiving MVP honors for the Mens' A/B session were **Winfred Walton** (Detroit Pershing) for the Blue Team and **Jason Price** (Okemos) for the Red Team. **Walton**, 1996 Mr. Basketball had a double-double with 24 points, leading all scorers and 10 boards. The Red Team was led by **Jarvis Mitchell** (Flint Central) with 22 points including 11 of 12 from the charity stripe. He was followed by **Dwayne Nash** (Saginaw) with 17, **Price** with 16, **Jon Champagne** (Linden) and **Jason Kreider** (DeWitt) with 15 each, **Tom Pauly** (Imlay City) adding another 11 points and **Todd Schrotenboer** (Grand Rapids South Christian) with 9. For the Blue Team, **Walton** was joined in the double figures scoring by **Kyle Hatcher** (Battle Creek Central) with 17 points, **Corey Tarrant** (Detroit Northwestern) and **Sylvestor Dotson** (Detroit Cooley) with 15 and 10 points respectively. They were followed by **Ron Hunter** (Plymouth Canton) with 9 points, **Ross Willick** (Grant) 8 points and **Tykie Reeves** (Ypsilanti Willow Run) with 7 points. In the rebounding department in addition to **Walton's** game high 10 rebounds, **Pauly**, **Schrotenboer** added 7 each.
