## THOMAS HURSEY DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

## 2003 \* GLEN BAGNALL \* GROSSE ILE



Longtime coach and BCAM board member, Glen Bagnall received the Thomas Hursey Distinguished Service Award at the Hall-of-Fame Banquet on October 4, 2003.

Glen served as the basketball coach at Grosse Ile High School for 36 years with a 381 – 313 win/loss record. His teams won nine League titles, 10 District and one Regional championships. He retired from Grosse Ile where he spent his entire teaching and coaching career.

Glen has served on the BCAM Executive Board of Directors since 1978 and served as president in 1983 and 1984. He was instrumental in organizing the BCAM Hall-of-Fame program and has served as its chairman since its inception in 1985. Since that time, 85 outstanding coaches have received the prestigious honor and he was inducted in 1990.

As a member of the Board of Directors for over 20 years, Glen has been one of the reasons for BCAM's growth and popularity. He was also named BCAM's Region 1 Coach-of-the-Year for the 1987-88 season.

Glen has been named the Huron League Coach-of-the-Year several times, four times in the 1980's as well as the Downriver Coach-of-the-Year and Detroit Free Press Metro Coach in 1987. He has served as Vice Chairman and State Chairman of Region IV of the NHSACA (National High School Athletic Coaches Association). Glen was inducted into the MHSCA (Michigan High School Coaches Association) in 1987.

As the seventh recipient of the Thomas Hursey Distinguished Service Award, Glen joins previous winners: Tom Hursey, Ron Vondette, Ed Dutcher, Stu Thorburn, Doug Herner and Peggy Porter.
