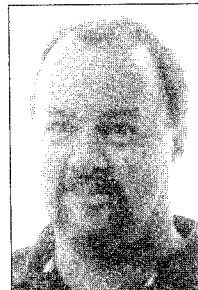


HALL of HONOR INDUCTEES

ASSISTANT COACH GARY GREIDER

Gary Greider started coaching basketball in 1980 at Dowagiac Union. He coached the boys 7th and 8th grade teams. In 1985 he moved to East Lansing and coached the 9th, JV and assisted with the varsity boys ('85-'89) and girls ('85-'90). His next coaching position was coaching 5th-8th grade teams in St Johns ('92-'98). Gary's present stint took him back to East Lansing in 2002 where he has coached 9th, JV and assisted with the varsity girls' team.

Gary has received numerous basketball awards. In 1990, he earned the BCAM Century Club award for 100 non-varsity coaching wins. As assistant, East Lansing teams have been CACC Conference champions ('89 & '90); the District & Regional champions ('90); CAAC Conference champions ('03-'10); made to four straight Quarterfinals (2007-2010); were State Runner's Up in 2008 and in 2010, the girls finished as the Class A State Champions.

Also serving as East Lansing's girls head varsity softball coach, Gary was named as the LSI Division I Area Coach-of-the-Year ('99) and in 2002 he earned the MHSSCA's 200 Victory Club Award.

Gary is married to wife, Sheryl and has a daughter and two sons.
