2014 BCAM MEN'S AND WOMEN'S COLLEGE ACADEMIC - ATHLETIC TEAMS

Each BCAM Honor Team pays tribute to five outstanding scholar-athletes from Michigan colleges and universities at the NCAA I, NCAA II, NCAA III, and NAIA levels. To be eligible, players have to be either a starter or an important reserve and have at least a 3.2 grade point average. The BCAM teams are selected on the basis of academic achievement, athletic accomplishments, grade point average and their coach's BCAM membership.

Sr Austin Armga Michigan Tech University 3.78 Waupon, WI

Austin is an All-GLIAC first team selection as well as a NABC first team All-Midwest Region Team and NCAA Midwest Region All-Tournament Team selection. He scored 736 points this past season which was second most in the nation. He finishes his career as Tech's career leader in FT% at 86.8%. He has a 3.78 GPA in Exercise Science.

Sr Travis Bader Oakland University 3.51 Okemos, MI

Travis will graduate in May with a Masters in Communication. This season he became the NCAA all-time leader in made three-point shots with 504. He finished second in the NCAA in FT% at 94%. He was a first team All-Horizon League selection as well as a Mid Major All-American. He has a 3.51 GPA.

Sr Derek Billing Lake Superior State University 3.59 Anna, OH

Derek was a selection to the All-GLIAC First Team as well as the GLIAC All-Tournament Team. He also received Daktronics and NABC All-Region honors this year. He set school records for career three-point made field goals and season made free throws. He has a 3.59 GPA in Exercise Science.

Sr Mark Ghafari Kalamazoo College 3.81 Grosse Pte Shores, MI

Mark is a two-time first team All-MIAA selection. This past season he was selected as the team's MVP as well as a first team Academic All-American. He is a three-year team captain and set the single season record for 3's in a season. He has a 3.81 GPA in Economics.

Sr Chene Phillips Wayne State University 3.51 Detroit, MI

Chene led the GLIAC in assists as well as minutes played in 2014. He was a two-time GLIAC All-Defensive Team selection and was named to the All-GLIAC second team for 2013-14 while averaging 15 points, 5 assists and 5 rebounds per game. He carries a 3.60 GPA in Finance.

Sr Brett de Bear Albion College 3.66 Plymouth, MI

Brett is a two-time All-MIAA selection. She finished 2nd on Albion's all-time scoring list (1,249 points) and her 450 points during the 2013-14 season was the 2nd most in a single season. She finished second in league scoring at 16.9 ppg, with overall numbers of 18 ppg, 5 rpg and 1.4 apg. Brett was voted team MVP (2x) and the team's Best Defensive Player. She has achieved distinction on the MIAA's Academic Honor Roll her first three seasons. Brett is an English major with a History minor, carrying a 3.66 GPA.

Jr Megan Fogt Hillsdale College 3.84 Anna, OH

Megan was named the 2013-14 GLIAC Player of the Year. She was honored as a 1st team all-league and 1st team All-American by the WBCA and Daktronics. Megan led the NCAA Division II in rebounding, including eight 20 rebound games. Her 22 double-doubles were the second-most in NCAA DII this season. Megan is earning a 3.84 GPA in Exercise Science.

Sr Kristen Greene Saginaw Valley State University 3.82 Brown City, MI

Kristen helped SVSU to its most wins in a season in over a decade. She led the team in points, rebounds, assists and steals, including setting the SVSU record in 3 point attempts in a career and the single season free throw percentage. Kristen was selected to the GLIAC second team all-league. Kristen majors in Nursing with a 3.82 GPA.

Sr Megan Kellev Hope College 4.00 Rockford, MI

Megan was a 1st team all-league selection and the MIAA Defensive Player of the Year. She has helped guide Hope College to a 77-8 record over her four years, while maintaining a 4.0 GPA the entire time. Megan also was honored as a CoSida Academic All-American. This season she was a team captain. Megan is a Math major in the College of Education.

Jr Breanna Verkaik Calvin College 3.63 Holland, MI

Breanna was named to the All-MIAA first team. She finished the season in the top 6 of six different statistical categories in the MIAA. This season Breanna led her team in scoring, rebounding and shooting percentage (55% FG, 82% FT, 40% 3 pt, 4.9 RPG). In addition, she was selected to the D3hoops.com Great Lakes All-Region third team. Breanna is a Nursing major with a 3.63 GPA.
