Daedra Charles — Miss Basketball

On January 10, 1987, Daedra Charles was presented the Miss Basketball Award which is voted by the Basketball Coaches Association of Michigan and sponsored by the Lansing State Journal. After the presentation at the Journal a photo session and luncheon were held at the Lansing Radisson Hotel.

Daedra Charles, a 6'3" center and two time Parade Magazine All-American, averaged 22 points and 16 rebounds this season. In four seasons, as a starter, she scored 1,962 points, had 1,397 rebounds and blocked 476 shots.

Coach Fred Procter said, "I don't think this state has seen a player like Daedra. She's a total player."

Daedra, the sixth recipient of the award, has yet to commit to any college or university, but has narrowed her choices to seven schools, Michigan State, Kansas, Ohio State, Kentucky, Georgia, Tennessee, and Iowa.

Her next appearance will be in the BCAM All-Star game on June 20th, 1987 at Central Michigan University.
