After three years at Bay City Central, Leo is returning to Saginaw where he had previously spent twenty-six years coaching varsity basketball.

Coach Boyd's teams have won 389 games while losing only 223 games throughout his career. Included in the teams wins are eight League Championships, fourteen District Titles and five Regional Titles. Leo has also coached teams to State Semi-Finals twice.

Personal honors were many for Coach Boyd. He has been Regional Coach of the Year three times, League Coach of the Year five times, and twice Saginaw News Coach of the Year.

Breckenridge High School

Matt has divided his coaching between two Michigan High Schools. He began his career at Flint St. Mary's, where he spent thirteen years amassing a record of 136 wins and 115 losses. He went on to coach at Breckenridge High School compiling a 203-137 won-loss record.

During his twenty-nine years of coaching, his teams have won three League Championships, nine District Titles and One Regional Title.



DICK EBERT
Holly High School
(retired)

June of 1986 hailed retirement from coaching for Dick Ebert.

During the twenty-seven years he coached, Dick held positions at five different high schools in Michigan. His teams earned winning records at all the schools. Dick ended his career with a total of 381 wins against 157 losses. His teams won seven League Championships, seven District Titles and two Regional Titles.

Mr. Ebert also coached Varsity Baseball for twelve years and was an Ass't. Varsity Coach in Football for nine years.

In 1977 Dick was honored as Oakland County Class B "Coach of the Year."



ALBERT (AL) SCHAFFER
Grand Haven High School

Coach Schaffer spent thirty one years coaching in Michigan dividing his time between positions in Litchfield (3 years), Blissfield (10 years), and Grand Haven (18 years). During his career his teams compiled a 373-250 won-loss record; won six League Titles and ten District Championships.

Al will continue his basketball coaching at Ramona High School in California.

B.C.A.M. has been fortunate to have Al actively working in their organization. He has served as President for three years and Chairman of Mr. Basketball for seven years.

In addition to coaching, Schaffer has served high school athletes as an official in football, baseball and track for twenty-seven years.
