

KENYON MURRAY - MR. BASKETBALL 1992

On March 23, 1992, Kenyon Murray of Battle Creek Central was named as the 12th recipient of BCAM and the Detroit Free Press' Mr. Basketball Award. Murray, coached by Chuck Turner, received electoral 432 points and was followed by Clarkston's Dugan Fife with 354 points.

Murray averaged 26 points and 10 rebounds per game. He scored a school and city record 1,448 career points. Murray was named the top scholar athlete at the McDonald's High School All-American game in Atlanta. The 6'5" Murray will continue his career and education at the University of Iowa on a basketball scholarship.

Kenyon will play with the Michigan All Star team against Ohio's All Stars June 20, in Grand Rapids. He will wear jersey #1, which goes to the annual Mr. Basketball award winner.
