Robert Traylor, 6' 9" center of Detroit-Murray Wright won the 15th annual Hal Schram Mr. Basketball award in March. Traylor says that simple hard work and support from his family were what helped him win the award. He thanked his grandmother and his aunt, Lydia Johnson (who starred at Detroit Mercy and played professional basketball for 11 years) for teaching him the fundamentals of the game, the fundamentals of life, and for always cheering the loudest. Traylor averaged 23 points, 15 rebounds and hit 65 per cent of shots for the 1994-95 season. He led his school to the Class A state championships last year.
