Jr Maria Blazejewski Lake Superior State University 3.7 Beulah, MI

Maria Blazejewski is a two-time All-Gliac 2nd Team performer. She carries a 3.7 GPA in Exercise Science. The 6'0 junior averaged 16.2 points per game which was good for fourth highest in the GLIAC rankings. She also earned the GLIAC Player of the Week twice and currently has scored 1,121 points through her junior season.
