At the end of the basketball regular season, schools are ranked by the MHSAA and the top 100 boy's teams and top 100 girl's teams (**whose Head Varsity Coach is a BCAM member**) are awarded with a banner to hang in their school's gym. (Thirty boys teams and 14 girls teams missed out on this award this year because their head coach was not a BCAM member.)
