2009 BCAM Men's Academic/Athletic Honors Team

Each BCAM Honor Team pays tribute to five outstanding scholar-athletes from Michigan colleges and universities at the NCAA I, NCAA II, NCAA III, and NAIA levels. To be eligible, players have to be either a starter or an important reserve and have at least a 3.2 grade point average. The BCAM teams are selected on the basis of academic achievement, athletic accomplishments, grade point average and their coach's BCAM membership.

Rob Boss

Spring Arbor University

Rob Boss is a junior forward who calls Brighton, Michigan home. He is on the Dean's list with a 3.77 GPA and a Business major. Rob has accumulated over 1,000 points and 600 rebounds in his career.
