Before playing for Harbor Springs, their Girl’s Basketball team went 18-61 with a .23 winning %, having not won a District in over a decade while averaging only 6-7 girls within the entire high school program. Since Olivia’s arrival, the program has more than doubled in size with # of girls, have won over 83% of their games, have captured a District Title along with 2 Conference Championships. Currently, the Rams are 20-2, ranked #7 in Division 3, and are the #1 seed heading into Districts and are poised to make a deep playoff run.

Olivia is currently ranked #11 on the All-Time Leading scorer list in MHSAA history with 2,301 points, not including post season play. She was awarded First Team All-State in each of the years she has played. More importantly, in 4 years, Olivia has never missed one single practice or game.
